OBJECTIVE

To encourage education and careers in the field of Business, Finance and/or Accounting within the Indigenous community.

ELIGIBILITY

Applications must be:

- Registered band member of Atlantic Canada or the Gaspé region of Quebec.
- Under 30 years of age as of December 31, 2024.
- Either currently enrolled in an undergraduate or graduate level certificate, diploma, and/or degree program, or a recent graduate in one of the following fields of study:
 - Accounting
 - Business Administration
 - Commerce
 - Finance
 - Management
 - Or related fields

HOW TO APPLY

Applicants are asked to submit:

- Completed application form.
- A two-page double-spaced essay emphasizing present and future contributions to business administration or commerce within the Indigenous community.
- Most recent transcript of marks from your college or university
- Letter of recommendation from a professor or advisor.
- Copy of your Certificate of Indian Status
